

Colour Chart for Cable and Bobble Stitch Blanket

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Using the Attic 24 Yarn Pack from Lucy's [Attic24 Granny Stripe Blanket](#).
Stylecraft Special DK Yarn

Before you start you will need to wind 25 g of Saffron, Spring Green and Meadow into separate little balls, because you will need to use 2 strands of the Saffron and the Spring Green at the same time in the 7th and 8th 4-row strips respectively and 2 strands of Meadow for the binding.

+ A plus inside a coloured box indicates that that colour should be added at the beginning of the specific 4-row strip in question. For example: The first strip has a plus in each box. This indicates that you should add all 3 yarns at the beginning of row 1.

B A B inside a coloured box indicates that that colour should be cut at the END of the specific 4-row strip in question. For example: The second strip has a B in the Wisteria box. This indicates that you should cut the Wisteria yarn at the end of row 8.

+B If a coloured box contains a Plus AND a B, it indicates that that colour should be added in at the beginning of the specific 4-row strip in question AND cut at the END of the specific 4-row strip in question. For example: The seventh strip has a plus AND a B in the Saffron box. This indicates that you should add in the Saffron yarn at the beginning of row 25 AND cut it at the end of row 28.
